


2020 AGM Response to Club Members


Mark will make contact directly with anybody posing other questions about the club finances.

3.0 ELECTION OF DIRECTORS


In accordance with the Articles of Association paragraph 36, Lara Taylor retired and was re-elected by a majority vote.



4.0 EXEC TEAM AND LEADERSHIP TEAM


In accordance with Club Rule 30, the Exec Team members resigned and were re-elected by a majority vote in the following roles:


27 Club Members kindly offered to help with club organisation. Members of the Exec Team will be in touch with each of these people over the next few weeks to discuss the opportunities further.
